The two-day course is a sports-specific course that addresses the Immediate Care training needs of doctors, nurses, physiotherapists and on-site medics working within sports. The course will draw on existing hospital immediate care courses, i.e. BLS, ACLS, PHTLS and ATLS, but have additional sports-specific modules such as on-field assessment of concussion, wound care and wound closure.

While catastrophic injuries are not common in sports events, it is essential when they do occur, that medical teams are appropriately prepared and trained for such an incident. In the UK, this requirement and the lack of advanced courses to specifically address these needs led to the development of the PSITCC by the England Rugby Football Union (RFU) in 2005.

To raise the standards of pitch side medical care in Asia, the Hong Kong College of Emergency Medicine and RFU brought the first course to Hong Kong in March 2010.
