

## **CPD & Training activities accredited for HKCEM Trainees**

### **Basic principles:**

- 1) All training activities should be approved by the Education Committee of HKCEM for training point allocation
- 2) Training activities organized by College or COC (A&E) or pre-approved by the Education Committee are allocated cat A training points.
- 3) Training activities other than 2) will be allocated cat B training points.
- 4) Principles of TP calculation:
  - 0.5 hour = 0.5 TP
  - 1 hour = 1 TP
  - Half-day = 3 TP
  - 1 day = 5 TP
  - $\geq 2$  days = 10 TP

### **Training Point (TP) requirement**

- 15 training points per 6-month period, with
  - At least 8 TP must be Cat. A
  - The rest can be Cat. B TP (or Cat. A TP)
- Excess Training Points earned in a particular 6-month period cannot be carried over to the next 6-month assessment period
- During elective training in other specialties, all the 15 TP can be either Cat A or Cat B (or both)
- Cat A Training Point activities
  - Educational activities organized by the HKCEM or COC (A&E) and other educational activities pre-approved by Education Committee of HKCEM as Cat A training activities
  - Examples (please refer to the table “training activities accredited with Category A Training Points” for details)
    - Joint Clinical Meeting (JCM)
    - Combined Toxicology Meeting organized by the HKPIC and College Toxicology Subcommittee
    - College Scientific Symposium
    - College Tutorial

- Cat B Training Point activities
  - Other (non-Cat A) training activities accredited by HKCEM
  - Examples
    - Accredited A&E Departmental training activities
    - Academic activities organized by the HKAM training unit that the trainee is currently in (for trainees on elective rotation to other units)
    - Academic activities accredited by HKAM College(s)

**List of Cat A and Cat B training activities**

- This list is not exhaustive and the program arrangement may change. The general principle is that the training points would be allocated according to the duration of the program.

College Scientific Symposium	8	1.5 days
Research Seminar	3	3 hours
Combined HKPIC and College Toxicology Subcommittee Meeting	2	2 hours
USG course	10	2 days course
Field Triage course	5	1 day course
Airway management workshop	5	1 day course
Literature appraisal workshop	10	2 days course
Surgical & Orthopaedic Skills workshop	10	2 days course
Induction course for new A&E residents	3	Half-day course

**Cat A training courses organized by College and/or other Organizations**

Training activities	Category A Training Points	Remarks
BLS	3	Half day
ACLS	10	2 days
AHLS	10	2 days
ALSO	10	2 days
APLS	10	2 days
ATLS	10	2 days

**Other academic / training activities**

Prior accreditation on individual basis is needed. Organizers need to apply early to ascertain the category (cat A or cat B) and the number of training points to be allocated.
